



RI-KWANGBA COMMUNIQUE

The Government of the Republic of Uganda (GOU) and the Lord's Resistance Army/Movement (LRA/M), having met at Ri-Kwangba on 13th and 14th of April, 2007, under the chairmanship and facilitation of the Special Envoy of the Secretary-General of the United Nations to the LRA-affected Areas, H.E. Mr. Joaquim Chissano, and in the presence of the Mediator of the GoU-LRA/M Peace Talks, H. E. Dr. Riek Machar Durghon-Teny, observers from Kenya, Mozambique, South Africa and Tanzania, and representatives of Ugandan religious, traditional and political leaders, have agreed as follows:


- 1) To review the Cessation of Hostilities Agreement (CoHA) and extend it to the end of the month of June, 2007.
- 2) To resume the peace talks in Juba on the 26th of April, 2007.
